TRAVIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 10


The Board of Directors of Travis County Municipal Utility District No. 10 will hold a regular meeting on Tuesday, May 5, 2026, at 10:30 a.m., at 17805 Kingfisher Ridge Cove, Lago Vista, Texas*, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. Approve Minutes.
3. Ratification of emergency or urgent actions, if any.
4. Engineering matters, including authorize design, approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids, review bids and award contracts, approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance, direct engineer to notify insurance company of new facility, as appropriate, for construction in the service area, including:
 - a. update on backwash pond pump analysis, including any proposals;
 - b. update on water well planning;
 - c. update regarding Waterford 4B and 2A development status; and
 - d. other engineering matters.
5. Operation of District facilities, including:
 - a. utility billings;
 - b. drought contingency status;
 - c. water treatment plant operation, repairs, and maintenance;
 - d. wastewater treatment plant repairs and maintenance;
 - e. grinder pump repairs;
 - f. remote deposits;
 - g. garbage collection matters; and
 - h. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
6. Approve Consumer Confidence Report and authorize operator to deliver Consumer Confidence Report and file certificate of delivery with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
7. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, and review of investments.
8. Discuss notifying delinquent taxpayers.
9. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, payment of tax bills, and proposed settlement of delinquent taxes.
10. Report regarding development in the District.
11. Consider Amended Development Financing Agreement and take any necessary action.

12. Report on District and property owner associations coordination and Board member input regarding issues facing the District.

15. Travel Reimbursement Guidelines and Director Expenses for the Association of Water Board Directors summer conference.
16. Cybersecurity and artificial intelligence training requirements.
17. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, to conduct a private consultation with attorney, and discuss pending or contemplated litigation, or a settlement offer.
18. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding matters considered in Executive Session, or a settlement offer.
